Friday July 27

This day comes in with a light breeze from the Nord steering N.W. & E. Nothing in sight Middle port a calm. latter part a light breeze made all sail cruising

Saturday July 28

This day comes in with a light breeze from the N.W. steering N.W. & E. and E.N.E. until sundown then shortened sail and hauled to the wind nothing in sight Middle port a calm. latter part a light breeze with rain squalls made all sail and about 6 o'clock AM our stied mate raised 3 large sperm Whales going to windward got our boats ready and lowered and pulled to windward. To end

Sunday July 29

This day comes in rain squalls the boats came on board about 5 PM without getting any, Whales went out of sight to windward. saw a merchant vessel at sundown shortened sail as usual Middle port the same. latter part a light breeze made all sail

This day comes in with a light breeze saw Grampases at sundown shortened sail as usual Middle port a calm latter part a calm. Water hoke out a hock of beef and making spun yarn

This day comes in with a light breeze from the S.P.E. heading along by the wind nothing in sight. at sundown shortened sail as usual. Middle port the same latter part a light breeze made all sail and steered off East

This day comes in with a light breeze from the S.E. saw Grampases at sundown shortened sail as usual the vessel leaking about the same Middle port the same. latter part a light breeze made all sail and steered off to the East Water hoke out Water
