Middle part - to same. latter part a good breeze made some sail and signaled the ship John Leiberger of Boston bound to Japan and got their longitude

117 Saturday Aug 11

This day comes in with a good breeze from the S.W. ship cruising at sundown shortened sail as usual middle part the same. latter part a moderate breeze made some sail. Henrik Bortesta a man forward

118 Sunday Aug 12

This day comes in with a moderate breeze from the S.W. nothing in sight. Weather broke out water. at sundown both in sail. middle part the same. latter part a good breeze made some sail

119 Monday Aug 13

This day comes in with a good breeze from the S.W. saw Grampases and Porpoises at sundown shortened sail as usual middle part more ship. latter part moderate breeze made some sail. Cruising

120 Tuesday Aug 14

This day comes in with a moderate breeze from the S.W. saw one sail and Grampases at sundown shortened sail as usual middle part more ship. latter part a good breeze but at the upper top sails and jib saw Grampases and Porpoises

Wednesday 15
This day comes in with a good breeze from the S.W. saw a sail and Porpoises. at sundown took in the upper top sails and jib middle part squally. latter part strong breeze more ship heading along by the wind

Thursday Aug 16
This day comes in with a strong breeze from the S.W. ship heading along by the wind under short sail. nothing in sight middle part the same. latter part squally more ship heading along by the wind

123

Friday Aug 17
This day comes in with a good breeze and rain squalls from the S.W. saw Porpoises. at sundown more ship middle part the same, latter part still a strong breeze. heading along by the wind

124

Saturday Aug 18
This day squally from the S.W. heading along by the wind under short sail at sundown spoke the Whaling ship Pearl Nelson. middle part the same. latter part still a strong breeze and squally weather broke out water

125

Sunday Aug 19
This day strong breeze and squally from the S.W. about 2 P.M. our Capt went on board the ship Pearl Nelson a little while. middle part the same latter part good weather made all sail heading along by the wind
