This day comes in with a light breeze from the N.E. the Pearl in sight - at sundown took in the light sails. Middle part the same. latter part light breeze made all sail heading along by the wind

This day comes in with a light breeze from the S.W. Water broke out 13 barrels of oil and coopered it and stowed it back. at sundown raining took in the light sails. saw the Pearl Nelson. Middle part the same. latter part light breeze made all sail steering E. S. E. saw the Pearl
