

1894 Journal of the Whaling Bark President  
Laying at Fyall

157 Thursday Sept 20  
This day rain squalls had the lighter  
and sent 12 casks of Oil on shore  
Capt Bravo discharged Henrick Barstener  
the man that was sick. Latter part  
called all hands at day light and  
went to breaking out the Oil

158 Friday Sept 21  
This day good weather finished breaking  
out the Oil and sent 12 casks on shore  
to day 49 casks all told also found  
shot leak on the port side midships  
in the main hatch. Latter part called all  
hands at day light and commenced siting up  
casks came on to rain and had to leave off

159 Saturday Sept 22  
This day raining hard nothing doing  
latter part called all hands at day light  
and commenced siting up casks

160 Sunday Sept 23  
This day comes in with heavy rain squalls  
siting up casks between the rain squalls  
also stoped a leak that we found the  
other day. Latter part nothing doing

161 Monday Sept 24  
This day comes in with good weather  
latter part called all hands at day light  
and siting up casks and stowing casks  
below in the ground tier

162 Tuesday Sept 25  
This day still siting up casks and stowing  
casks below in the ground tier, latter part  
called all hands at day light and went  
to siting up casks and stowing casks below

163 Wednesday Sept 26  
This day comes in with good weather buy  
siting up casks and stowing them below  
latter part called all hands at day light  
and went to siting up casks and taking  
Water on board from shore

164 Thursday Sept 27  
This day siting up casks and stowing  
them below and taking water on board  
from shore latter part called all hands  
at day light and sent our casks on shore  
for Water and siting up casks

165 Friday Sept 28  
This day taking Water on board and  
siting up casks and stowing them below  
latter part called all hands at day light  
blowing strong with rain squalls. The Pilot  
came on board and we hove our chains  
in laught and siting up casks

166 Saturday Sept 29  
This day comes in with rain squalls  
sent our casks on shore and filled them  
with Water and took it on board got all  
our Water on board to day about 200 barrels  
latter part called all hands at day light  
and put down some salt Water and  
boopered some of the Provisions and  
stowed them away
