

1894 Journal of the Whaling Bark President

Made all sail and light steaming
off St. Mark employed in ship duty

219 Wednesday Nov 21

This day comes in with rain squalls
took in all sail except lower topsails
and hauled to the wind. Nothing in sight
middle part the same. latter part good
weather made all sail. Mark broke out water

220 Thursday Nov 22

This day comes in with a moderate breeze
with rain squalls ship cruising saw
black fish at sundown shortened sail
as usual. middle part wore ship. latter
part raining hard

221 Friday Nov 23

This day comes in with a moderate breeze
and raining. saw Grampases. middle
part the same. latter part made all
sail heading along by the wind

222 Saturday Nov 24

This day comes in with a moderate breeze
from the E. ship cruising saw
Pompanos at sundown took in the
light sails and upper fore top sail
middle part the same. latter part
moderate breeze and cloudy but at
upper fore top sail and main sail

This day comes in with a good breeze
from the E. and raining steady ship
heading along by the wind & cruising
saw one Merchant Vessel at sundown
took in the mainsail. middle part
wore ship. latter part good weather made
some sail and after breakfast gained
the ship Pearl Nelson

Monday Nov 26

This day comes in with a moderate
breeze from the E. left off gaming
and standing along by the wind
nothing in sight but the ship. middle
part the same. latter part good weather
made all sail heading along by the wind
to the N. and E. and E. and

Tuesday Nov 27

This day comes in with a good breeze from
the E. heading along by the wind
saw Black fish. middle part the same
latter part cruising

Wednesday Nov 28

This day comes in with a moderate breeze
from the E. heading along by the wind
to the N. and E. saw a few backs
and another Whale that we could not
make out as he was some ways off. middle
part the same. latter part good weather
still heading along by the wind
bound up to St. Augustine
