393 Tuesday May 14

This day comes in with a good breeze from the E. S. E. steering N. W. W. with all sail set. Weather employed in ship's duty. Nothing in sight. Middle part the same. Latter part a moderate breeze.

394 Wednesday May 15

This day comes in with a moderate breeze from the E. S. E. steering N. W. W. with all sail set. Nothing in sight. Middle part the same. Latter part wind hauled to the S. with rain squalls steering N. W. W. with all sail set.

395 Thursday May 16

This day comes in with a light breeze from the W. S. W. saw one sail. Weather employed in ship's duty. Middle part squally. Latter part about a calm.

396 Friday May 17

This day comes in with squally weather from the E. N. E. steering N. W. W. with all sail set. Saw a steamer. Middle part raining. Latter part still raining and squally took in the mainsail and upper top sail and jib.

397 Saturday May 18

This day comes in with a moderate breeze from the E. S. E. steering N. W. W. set the top sails and jib. Saw one sail. Middle part the same. Latter part good weather. Made all sail.

Wabts took off new fore upper top sails braces 2 3/4 inches wide

399 Monday May 20

400 Tuesday May 21

This day comes in with a moderate breeze from the N. E. steering N. W. W. with all sail set. Nothing in sight. Middle part the same. Latter part light breeze steering the same.

401 Wednesday May 22

This day comes in with a light breeze from the E. N. E. steering N. W. W. with all sail set. Nothing in sight. Middle part the same. Latter part a light breeze from N. W. to heading along by the wind with all sail set.

402 Thursday May 23

This day comes in with a calm. Nothing in sight. Middle part a moderate breeze from the N. E. Latter part a good breeze took in the top sails heading along by the wind.
