Cruising on Western Ground

435 Friday July 5

This day comes in with good weather
the boats came on board at dark
without getting any, the whales went
out of sight. We took in the light sails
middle part the same. latter part a
good breeze made some sail cruising

436 Saturday July 6

This day comes in with a good breeze
from the N.W. ship cruising saw
the James Arnold at sundown
took in some sail. middle part the
same. latter part good weather made
all sail cruising

437 Sunday July 7

This day comes in with good weather
wind from the N.E. ship cruising
saw one sail. at sundown
took in the light sails. middle part
steering off N.W. latter part good weather
made all sail steering N.W.

438 Monday July 8

This day comes in with good weather
ship steering to the N.W. about five
o'clock P.M. gained the Brig F.A. Barstow
at sundown shortened sail
middle part the same. latter part
good weather made all sail cruising

439 Tuesday July 9

This day comes in with good weather
gaining the Brig F.A. Barstow
saw fire basket at sundown took
in the light sails. middle part the same
latter part good weather made all sail

440 Wednesday July 10

This day comes in with a very light
breeze from the S.W. ship cruising with
all sail set. the Brig in sight
at sundown took in the light sails
middle part the same. latter part good
about a calm

441 Thursday July 11

This day comes in with a very light
breeze from the S.W. steering off E.N.E.
gaining the Brig. nothing shore in sight
middle part the same. latter part
very light breeze steering off E.N.E.

442 Friday July 12

This day comes in with a calm
the Brig still in sight also saw
Grandpares. middle part the same
latter part still a calm

443 Saturday July 13

This day comes in with a calm
the Brig still in sight. middle part
a calm. latter part a very light
breeze from the S.W. steering off
E.N.E. in company with the Brig
