Sunday July 14

This day comes in with a very light breeze from the W.S. steering E.N.E. in company with the Brig saw Grampians middle port at same. latter port good weather. Made all sail and about 4 o'clock A.M. saw a large lone Sp. Whale going to sundown quick got our boats ready and lowered. and finally the whale went out of sight and Boats got on board about noon

Monday July 15

This day comes in with good weather ship working to sundown at sundown took in the light sails. Our boat went along side of a star marked wh and got some papers. one Whaling Bark in sight. middle port - the same latter port good weather made all sail cruising

Tuesday July 16

This day comes in with a light breeze ship cruising about 3 o'clock P.M. gained the ship Sarah W. Hunt and Bark Petrel. at sundown took in the light sails. middle port steering off E by N. latter port good weather made all sail cruising saw three sails. Water broke and water

This day comes in with a very light breeze ship cruising. picked up a part of a wrecked and got some fish saw a steamer at sundown took in the light sails middle port at same. latter port good weather made all sail cruising

Thursday July 18

This day comes in with a moderate breeze from the S.W. ship heading along by the wind saw one sail and Purpases. at sundown took in the light sails. middle port at same latter port good weather made all sail steering E.S.

Friday July 19

This day comes in with a moderate breeze from the S.W. ship cruising. saw Purpases at sundown took in the light sails and main sail. middle port the same. latter port good weather made all sail and steered off E by S.

Saturday July 20

This day comes in with a good breeze from the W.S. saw Purpases at sundown shortened sail as usual middle port a strong breeze took in the fore sail. latter port squally with a strong breeze
