In Port. finished painting the vessel in side

Saturday Sept. 21th.

In Port crew employed getting the Potatoes on aboard

Sunday Sept. 22th.

In Port. got all the recruits on board and got the vessel ready for sea

Monday Sept. 23th.

In Port Thelip Gomes came aboard as second mate shipped him and shipped Mr. Garcia Mate John Ch. Aguedo Boatsteerer and Solomon dos Santos third mate

Tuesday Sept. 24th.

In Port got the vessel clear and flying jib boom out

Wednesday Sept. 25th.

The crew employed unmooring the vessel

Thursday Sept. 26th.

These 24 hours fresh breeze took a tug boat and towed the vessel to sea

Trade, Thomas Silo, Blanca, Manuel F. dos Santos, Jose Ignacio Garcia Manuel Vieira Squadrado green hand Cicilio, M^{te} Delgado and Antonio Almeida going try them boatsteerer

Saturday Sept. 28th.

This day Pleasant weather the Island of St. Michael in sight, course S E.

Sunday Sept. 29th.

These 24 hours first part pleasant weather the Island of St. Mary in sight; latter part raining and blowing strong from S East Vessel hove to on Port tacke

Monday Sept. 30th.

This day comes comes with a light gale hauling to Westward and with steady rain the wind blowed the fore top stay sail way, bend on a new one
