These 24 hours first rain and squally weather; latter part blowing a light gale from Northward, course S. by West.

Wednesday Oct. 2th.

This day comes with a light gale of wind from Northward with rough sea. the vessel started licking course S. by West.

Thursday Oct. 3th.

This day comes with a gale from N East; course S. by West.

Friday Oct. 4th.

These 24 hours first part strong breeze from Northward, course S. by West sighted a sailing vessel; latter part light airs and calms with heavy swell running course the same. broke out for slops for the crew. a sailing vessel in sight, caught two dolphins.

Saturday Oct. 5th.

These 24 hours cloudy weather calms and and light breeze from S East. course S. by West. everything set.

Sunday Oct. 6th.

These 24 hours smoky weather and light breeze. course S. by West a vessel in sight.

Monday Oct. 7th.

These 24 hours first part pleasant breeze and cloudy weather; latter part strong trades. course S by West, sighted two sailing vessels.

Tuesday Oct. 8th.

This day comes with strong trades and rough sea. course South sighted two sailing vessels heading West.

Wednesday Oct. 9th.

These 24 hours strong trades and cloudy weather, saw a school of black fish and porpoises vessel cruising at night shorten sails. Lat 21°30' Long. 20°20'

Thursday Oct. 10th.

These 24 hours pleasant breeze ship cruising. nothing in sight at night shorten sail as usual. Lat. 21°38' Long. 20°50'.

Friday Oct. 11th.

These 24 hours first part calms and very light airs, at night lowered the boats down to try the crew. latter part dead calm raised two large whales, got the boats ready and lowered down the S. Boat got fast. plenty black fish around the vessel.
