These 24 hours first part strong trades, jammed Brig Francis to. Paston; latter part the same kind of weather with rough sea the same vessel in sight saw porpoises and plenty pieces of squid

Saturday Nov. 2th.

This day comes with a light gale from Eastward

Sunday Nov. 3th.

This day comes with a gale from Eastward, saw a Hinback

Monday Nov. 4th.

This day comes with a moderate gale

Tuesday Nov. 5th

These 24 hours strong trades and smoky weather

Wednesday Nov. 6th.

This day first part strong trades; latter part pleasant fresh trades all sails set, cruising saw black fish and porpoises

Thursday Nov. 7th.

These 24 hours pleasant light trades ship cruising all sails set, saw porpoises

Friday Nov. 8th.

This day first part pleasant light trades, vessel cruising at night shortened sails; latter part the same kind of weather, at 8 o'clock raised alone whale lowered the boats down and S. Boat got fast at 10 the West boat came aboard stowed, Capt nailed a piece of canvas over the hole ready for use, lost the mast and sail

Saturday Nov. 9th

These 24 hours first part pleasant trades the S. Boat came aboard stowed, Capt. sent the second mate in West boat latter on got the S. Boat fixed and sent the third mate help to kill the whale at dark got the whale along side when fluking her lost one chain latter part separate the head from the body

Sunday Nov. 10th.

These 24 hours fresh trades cut in the whale body and started the fires; latter part the head chain parted, but got her long side again hooked on junk, and lost the feet
