Sunday Jan. 26th.

These 24 hours first part strong trade latter part light trades St. Vincent and St. Antonio Islands in sight

Monday Jan. 27th.

These 24 hours first part light airs and foggy weather Capt went shore in St. Antonio and brought Manoel Grai Silva on board as a green hand latter part calms and light airs saw a whaling Schr. to leeward of Antonio

Tuesday Jan. 28th

These 24 hours fresh trades Capt. Mandy of Schr. Charly Hogdon came aboard of us a little while

Wednesday Jan. 29th.

These 24 hours comes with nice weather took the West boat on deck and put the spare boat in his place and painted him, a whaler in sight

Thursday Jan. 30th.

These 24 hours pleasant trades raised a school of small whales got the boats ready and lowered so. Boat got fast but the line parted and the whales started to windward the boats kept after them but soon lost sight of them a whaler in sight
