These 24 hours first part light breeze rolled in the whale body and started the fire, Capt. of Schr. Sarah W. Hunt came aboard a little while latter part pleasant weather, hove in the junk on deck and bail out the case a whaling Schr. in sight.

Thursday Feb. 13th.

These 24 hours comes with light breeze, all hands on deck cutting up junk and blubber spoke Schr. Sarah W. Hunt she had 3 whales long side, sighted 2 sailing vessels.

Friday Feb. 14th.

These 24 hours first part fresh breeze employed boiling, latter part calm and light breeze, saw the Schr. Sarah W. Hunt chasing whales, we got the two quarter

boats ready and lowered the Schr. boats got fast and the whales started to run kept on boiling.

Saturday Feb. 15th.

These 24 hours first part pleasant light breeze the boats kept chasing but the whales wouldn't let them get near enough, at night they returned aboard, finished boiling latter part light air and calm employed stowing down saw black fish, two whales in sight.

Sunday Feb. 16th.

These 24 hours nice pleasant weather two whales in sight.

Monday Feb. 17th.

These 24 hours pleasant weather saw two whales and a sailing vessel.

Tuesday Feb. 18th.

These 24 hours comes with squally and fresh trades, sighted a whaler.

Wednesday Feb. 19th.

These 24 hours comes with squally and strong trades, sighted a whaler Steward off sick with rumination.
