Wednesday May 27th.

These 24 hours comes with rain squally cloudy weather and light breeze saw finbacks.

Thursday May 28th.

These 24 hours comes with cloudy weather light breeze and calms saw porpoises and sighted two sailing vessels.

Friday May 29th.

These 24 hours comes with light Easterly wind course West, saw finbacks and porpoises, broke out for provisions, and set up two oil casks.

Saturday May 30th.

These 24 hours comes with pleasant light airs, course West. saw a finback.

Sunday May 31st.

These 24 hours comes with pleasant light breezes from Eastward course West saw porpoises and grampus.

Monday June 1st.

These 24 hours first-part light breezes from Eastward, course West at night shortened sails and hove to; latter part very light-airs, made all sails and steer West pick up a barril of kerosene, at 11 A.M. sighted a school of small whales got the boats ready and lowered the West Boat got fast the whales brought to and the other boats got fast also, West boat brought the whales long side and the other two boats chasing.

Tuesday June 2nd.

These 24 hours first-part calms the S. Boat got fast the other boats chase off for while but couldn't get chance so they went help to tow the mates whale got the whale long side and put up the cutting gear, latter part dead calms cut the whales in.
