

Wednesday June 3th.

These 24 hours first part dead calm cut up the whales heads, and started the fires; latter part breezing up from Southward with heavy clouds, cutting up horse pieces and boiling sighted a sailing vessel.

Thursday June 4th.

These 24 hours first part blowing a strong breeze with heavy clouds, kept on boiling; middle part blowing a heavy gale with rain squally, put out the fires and put the rest of the blubber down on hole. Latter part wind hauled round to S.W. moderate breeze, set the fires again, and got the blubber out the hole.

Friday June 5th.

These 24 hours first part strong breeze, and heavy swell, finished boiling, latter part stowing down the oil and, setting up a few oil casks.

Saturday June 6th.

These 24 hours comes with strong breeze from S.West and squally weather.

Sunday June 7th.

These 24 hours comes with squally weather with heavy swell, saw a finback and porpoises.

Monday June 8th.

These 24 hours comes with strong breeze from Westward with heavy clouds and choppy sea saw porpoises.

Tuesday June 9th.

These 24 hours comes with light breezes and rain squally saw porpoises and a finback.

Wednesday June 10th.

These 24 hours comes with fresh breeze and squally weather on first part, saw a finback; latter part light breeze and cloudy weather saw porpoises and a finback.

Thursday June 11th.

These 24 hours first part strong breeze from S.West; latter part blowing a light gale from the same quarter

Friday June 12th.

These 24 hours first part blowing a light gale of wind with a heavy swell; latter part moderate breeze and heavy swell raining.

Saturday June 13th.

These 24 hours comes with fresh breeze and foggy weather, with drizzling rain nothing in sight.
