Wednesday June 24th.

These 24 hours first part pleasant weather all sails set cruising; saw a rotten small whale, at night shortened sail; latter part strong breeze and rainy weather

Thursday June 25th.

These 24 hours comes with a light gale from Westward with rain, saw some kind of fish breaching, supposed to be grampus

Friday June 26th.

These 24 hours first part strong breeze heavy rain, and heavy swell, wind hauling to Northward; latter part wind shifted to E. blowing strong with heavy swell

Saturday June 27th

These 24 hours first part fresh breeze and heavy swell; sighted a small whale. latter part pleasant weather all sails set steering West

Sunday June 28th.

These 24 hours first part pleasant light wind from Eastward, all sails set steering West, at night shortened sails and hove to; latter part pleasant fresh breeze about 6 o'clock raised a school of large whales got the boats ready and lowered L. and S. boats boats went on several times but the whales perceived them and finally they went out of side some to leeward and some to windward, and the boats came aboard

Monday June 29th.

These 24 hours first part pleasant fresh breeze at twelve o'clock raised a lone whale coming to leeward lowered the two quarter boats and S. Boat got fast at 3. got the whale alongside put up the cutting gear and hooked on the whale and got the jaw on deck; latter part called all hands at daylight, separate the head and heave in the body

the whale made 97 lbs.

Tuesday June 30th

These 24 hours comes with pleasant weather hove the jacks on deck bail out the case and set the fires, and took down the cutting gear, carried away one of the S. Boat davits.
