These 24 hours first part calm and light-rain squally; latter part very light-air from S.E. course N.E. all sails set saw grampus, one sail in sight

Sunday July 26th.

These 24 hours comes with calm and very light-air all sails set working to Northward

Monday July 27th.

These 24 hours comes with calm and light-air all sails set working to Northward

Tuesday July 28th.

These 24 hours comes with light-air vessel cruising, a merchant ship in sight

Wednesday July 29th.

These 24 hours first light-breeze, raised 3 large whales got the boats ready and lowered, the West boat got close to the whale, gave the boat on top of the whale, she saw him shot a head and was she went, the boats kept chasing till dark, and then came on board latter part fresh breeze from W.N.W. vessel heading by the wind to Westward
