D. Commerce moderate and heavy. P.M. got underway and steamed to the westward around the Island. Met L. H. and Shumway. P.P.B. Landed for Cow and calf. Arrived back 4.30 P.M. Came aboard P.P. Landed again and about 5 P.M. talked to Cow. 10 P.M. took the whole alongside and made sail ready to the immediate East Shumway.

Henry 18th

2. Commenced heavy packing to commence with
the whole baggage. 11 AM came to anchor at New St. Regis and
commenced getting ready to start. Until came 1 PM Commenced
packing. Capt went to Port Presque to pay passage fees, 5th PM
returned.
