

Saturday March 28-1868

C-M got underway saw plenty of whales but very little. 4 Pm anchored off Portia.

Sunday 29th

Spending at Portia. C-M landed for a permit to permit William Phillips of St. Eustacia in the Hospital. returned and took the man to the Hospital and he died a few minutes after getting there. C-M buried him the crew attending the funeral.

Monday 30th

C-M put Portia in the Hospital with the shattering. I-M got underway to cruise. Sailed several times but got nothing. 5-30 anchored at Pigeon Island.

Tuesday March 31st

Strong trade. C-M underway. I lowered for whale and very few minutes back at boat. 1-30 Pm anchored at Pigeon Island.

Wednesday April 1st 1868

C-M got underway. Strong breeze. Sailed for whale several times. Saw against one but did not fasten. 5-Pm anchored at Pigeon Island.

Thursday April 2^d 68

C-M got underway to cruise. Sailed and saw against a whale but did not fasten. Whales plenty but nothing. 5-30 anchored at Pigeon Island.

Friday April 3^d 68

Strong breeze. C-M got underway saw several whales but nothing. 4-Pm anchored at Pigeon Island.

Saturday April 4th

C-M got underway to cruise 10-20 struck a whale 11-30 lowered the boom. I-M has to off Portia and sent a boat in for provisions. Saw the Hospital. 2-30 the boat returned. lowered for whale but got nothing. 5-30 anchored at Pigeon Island.

Sunday April 5th 68

Very strong breeze and also weather. Spying at Pigeon Island.

Monday April 6th

Very fresh breeze. C-M got underway saw two and self hit but not lower for them. 1-Pm anchored at Pigeon Island.

Tuesday April 7th

C-M got underway. I saw the Estelle fast to a whale. 8-30 Capt. Saw away for material. 2-30 took his line 1-30 cut from the 3 miles to surround of St. Lucia. 3-Pm anchored at Pigeon Island.

Wednesday April 8th

C-M got underway to cruise. It saw nothing. 2-Pm strong trade and squally anchored off Portia.

Thursday April 9th

Fresh breeze and squally. C-M got underway saw nothing. 2-Pm anchored at Pigeon Island.

Friday 10th

C-M got underway. I lowered and struck a whale but the boom came out without fastening the boom weak but 4-Pm anchored at Pigeon Island.

Saturday April 11th

C-M got underway saw nothing. 4-Pm anchored at Pigeon Island.
