51-50 and cloudy I.P. equally fresh maintained and set
tysail. End light P.W. winds and overcast.

Thursday July 30th

31-44 commenced light P.W. and overcast & made sail
51-44 and same I.P. spoke P. Sarg & spoke Argonau End
fresh P.W. and clear

Friday July 31st

31-44 commenced fresh P.W. and cloudy & made sail
51-44 several whaling in sight & saw Blackfish (but and latter
part fresh breeze from W. Dr. [lost (to)] some Correll met here

31-44 commenced fresh breeze from W. Dr. & made sail saw two
51-28 whales (but and latter part gentle breeze from W.

Sunday August 2nd

31-44 commenced light P.W. wind and fine weather (but
51-14 light air from S.E. two whales in sight End same

Monday Aug 3rd

31-00 light air from the southwest and fine weather
52-15 through the 24 hours

Tuesday Aug 4th

31-48 light winds and variable through the 24 hours
51-50 10 AM spoke S.E. Antarctic several whaling boats in sight

Wednesday Aug 5th

31-40 light air and variable through the 24 hours
51-44 several whales in sight

Thursday August 6th

31-28 light air and variable through the 24 hours
51-04 saw several whales

Friday Aug 7th

31-00 light air and variable two whaling barques in sight
5-13

Saturday Aug 8th

31-48 light air and variable through the 24 hours
40-33 three whaling barques in sight saw Blackfish

Sunday Aug 9th

31-48 light air from the Eastward and fine weather

Monday Aug 10th

31-29 light air from the Eastward and fine weather (but
49-48 commenced light breeze through the 24 hours from C.W. side
End P.W.

Tuesday Aug 11th

31-40 light winds and variable through the 24 hours
48-31

Wednesday Aug 12th

31-05 light winds from the Eastward and fine weather

Thursday Aug 13th 33V

31-00 commenced light breeze and clear P.W. from
49-40 commenced light breeze and clear P.W. from
7-00 commenced light breeze and clear P.W. from
the Head return End fresh P.W. and rough

Friday Aug 14th

31-00 commenced fresh P.W. & P.W. more moderate and smooth
commenced cutting (but P.W. working on the Head 4 PM
finished and started the Argonau of course that the Argonau
was the side of the Steer and split off. Heavy tons
of the ship's plank with it but could not sail at
an account of better wood
