

22-30 Saturday Aug 14<sup>th</sup> 1874.

42-31 Light breeze from S.E. and fine weather. Employed  
sailing ship John's Elbridge Dwyer.

Sunday Aug 15<sup>th</sup>

Light S.E. breeze and fine weather. Sailing

Monday Aug 16<sup>th</sup>

Light breeze from S.E. and pleasant. C.P. Dwyer finished  
sailing and returned home. Boat appeared. East fresh  
S.E. and cloudy.

Tuesday Aug 17<sup>th</sup>

Commenced fresh S.E. winds and cloudy. The wind all  
the day. Wind strong breeze & S.E. saw Whaling Boats coming  
& took in sail. East fresh S.E. and overcast.

Wednesday Aug 18<sup>th</sup>

36-44 Commenced fresh S.E. and developed that land 10 AM.

45-50 saw whaling Boats coming. C.P. Dwyer under. East fresh  
S.E. and equally strong to the Eastward by the wind.

Thursday Aug 19<sup>th</sup>

38-52 Light breeze from S.E. and heavy through the 24 hours  
44-50 carrying all sail to the Eastward. Saw Steamships  
and several Merchantmen.

Friday Aug 20<sup>th</sup>

38-01 Light S.W. breeze and fine weather through  
42-34 the 24 hours. Carrying all sail to the Eastward. Saw  
Steamships and several Merchantmen.

Saturday Aug 21<sup>st</sup>

38-06 Light S.W. breeze and fine weather through  
40-55 the 24 hours. Saw several Merchantmen.

Monday Aug 22<sup>nd</sup> 1874

Commenced light winds and variable. But light E.S.E.  
W.P. spoke John King & Simmons. Small fine breeze from  
S.E. strong to Eastward.

Tuesday Aug 23<sup>rd</sup>

38-01 Light and fair. Part light S.E. and fine weather  
42-52 saw several vessels. Saw Steamships. East fresh S.E. and equally  
strong to Eastward. Winds easy sail.

Wednesday Aug 24<sup>th</sup>

38-58 Commenced fresh S.E. and equally. S. Breeze all day  
42-52 Part fresh breeze and clear. The sun showed. S. Breeze  
but saw nothing after. 6-30 took in mainmast.  
East fresh breeze and equally strong to the Eastward.

Thursday Aug 25<sup>th</sup>

38-52 Commenced light S.W. breeze and small. All day saw  
46-01 several Merchantmen and one Whaling Boat. Part pleasant  
Saw Steamships. 6-30 took in mainmast. East fresh S.E. and  
strong to the Eastward.

Friday Aug 26<sup>th</sup>

38-12 Commenced Part S.E. and fine weather. S. Breeze  
44-30 saw 10 spoke Wayne Black Eagle of New Bedford.  
Part fresh breeze from S.E. 6-30 took in mainmast.  
East fresh breeze and clear.

Saturday Aug 27<sup>th</sup>

32-27 Light breeze from S.W. and pleasant through  
42-27 the 24 hours. C.P. Dwyer under. E.S.E. 20 miles  
ship. Took in sail. East light breeze from S.W. carrying  
under easy sail off shore.
