first part thick fog course 10 by 10 wind N by E
employed in various jobs middle part of fine breeze
N by W heading 11 by 11 latter part calm employed in
various jobs Lat 58:22 Long 73:56

Friday first part light air South course 11 by 11 employed in
making a green to ligament mast and various other
jobs middle part calm latter part wind W by W heading
N by W brack out the after booms after corn and Bread
swords Lat 58:26 Long 76:40

Saturday first part fresh gales from N by W by W
heading 11 by 11 double reefed the fore
topsails main sails and fished the jib middle
part fished the fore and mizen topsails abast
reefed the main fished the main sail and fore
sail latter part raining and blowing a fresh gale
from N by W heading 11 by 11 sails

Lat 59:00 Long 78:18

Sunday first part more moderate set two jobs
7 fore sail main sail and double reef topsails
3 islands of ice in sight at 5 o'clock were ship heading
N by W middle part snow storm and calm latter part
light air all round the compass scenes

Monday first part calm and foggy middle part squally and
snowy wind from N by W to N by W double reefed the tops
sails tack ship 2 latter part light breeze N by W heading
N by W mizen sail sails

Tuesday first morning at 3 o'clock a fine breeze N by W
middle part squally wind called from N by W to N by W
tacked ship latter part wind from N by W to N by E
and morning scenes Lat 58:42 Long 81:35

Wednesday first part fresh gales South and morning at 10
o'clock called all hands and fished all sails except
abast reef main topsails reef fore sail and stay sails
middle part snow squalls latter part made all sail at 10
tacked ship wind N by W heading 11 by 11 Lat

Passage around Cape Horn November 11th 1835
first part fresh gale from N by W to N by W fished all except
abast reef main topsails and reef fore sail and stay sails
middle part fresh gales at 10 o'clock the fore sail at 11
tacked ship ^{from the 10 o'clock} latter part at 6 set the fore and
main sail heading 11 by 11 at 8 tacked ship heading
from N by W to N by E scenes

Thursday first part fresh gales from N by W to N by W heading
13 from N by W to N by W at 7 fished the main sail middle
part fresh gales and squally latter part the same scenes
Lat 58:16 Long 82:55

Saturday first part heading 11 by 11 wind N by W at
13 4 o'clock tack ship heading 11 by 11 rather more
moderate set abast main sail middle part set abast
reef fore and mizen topsails latter part at 7 tack ship
heading 11 by 11 at 10 tack ship heading 11 by 11 scenes

Sunday first part a fine N by W course 11 by 11 made all
14 sail middle part calm latter part light air N by E
N by E course 11 by 11 scenes Lat 56:45
Long 83:37

Monday first part pleasant light air N by E course 11 by 11
15 middle part calm latter part of fine breeze N by W
heading 11 by 11 brack out the main hatch way after water
scenes

Tuesday first part squally double reefed the topsails and main
16 sail at 6 brack out the reefs out of the fore and
main topsails wind N by E course 11 by 11 middle part
foggy made all sail wind from N by E to E latter part
all hands employed in packing vacuum on account
of some iron hardware weighting which was found on
the scuttles but scenes Lat 54:22 Long 86:02

Wednesday first part a fine breeze from N by E course 11 by 11 the
17 gale came forward and carried his part middle part
squally wind and course the same latter part
the same scenes Lat 51:40
