

Coast off Chile November December 3rd 1835

Friday first part of fine breeze ^{all hands} South ^{hauled} West ^{hauled} bent the stanchion and finished fitting and Boat and various other jobs middle part at 12 part 3 lashed in to the Eastward latter part foggy at 5 were off shore calm broke out the after hoist after Bread Meat Dried apples and Sugar and filling the Capt. boat 3 sails in night scenes

Saturday first part light air ^{all hands} and hauling the land by estimation 15 mi of finish fitting the Boat 3 sails in night middle part latter part calm all hands employed in ship's duty and foggy scenes Sat Long

Sunday first part pleasant but calm all hands employed in various jobs lowered after Porpoises but without success middle and latter calm lowered after Pteroplachs but without success Sat 33:05 Long

Monday first part one watch below at 5 o'clock lowered after 2 Blackfish caught 2 fastened to 1 more and parted middle part of fine Breeze & course N.W. later part ^{all hands} later part lowered after Blackfish killed 4 and saved one at 10 commenced boiling Sat 31:41 Long 72:00

Tuesday first part pleasant wind & course N.E. at 3 o'clock finished boiling middle part course S.W. later part employed in ship's duty Sat 27:00 Long 72:00

Wednesday first part pleasant wind & light course W all hands employed in various jobs on bent the mainstays middle part commenced standing boats watches latter part painting Boats and various other jobs scenes Sat 26:11

Thursday first part cloudy wind & course N.E. & bent the fore mast and main topgallant sail and Mr Conant employed in making a pannel lower middle part the same latter part employed in breaking out the lower hoist after water runs

Friday first part of fine breeze to the Southward but slowly 10 course from N to N.W. finished stowing off the main hatch way and various other jobs middle part pleasant

latter part at 4 past 6 raised a school off Blackfish and lowered in pursuit of them sunk 2 and saved 2 and came alongside and in hoisting the old Boat broke her in halves scenes Lat 23:20

Saturday first part pleasant 11 leading N.E. to N.W. wind South at 4 past 12 lowered sunk 1 and saved 2 middle part all well latter part at 5 o'clock called all hands and at 8 commenced boiling and various other jobs scenes

Sunday first part fine breeze steering from N.E. to 13 N.W. at 3 o'clock finished boiling and cleared up decks and put out new boats and took in one middle and latter the same scenes Sat 20:14

Monday first part pleasant wind & steering N.W. 14 at 3 o'clock raised a school off sperm whales at 4 past 3 lowered struck 3 and saved 1 and crawled from the other 2 at 4 past 4 returned with one middle part lying aback at 5 o'clock called all hands and began to cut at 4 past 4 finished cutting and at 11 o'clock began to Boil scenes Lat 19:31 Long

Tuesday first part pleasant wind South steering from 15 N.W. to N.W. saw a schooner all employed in boiling middle part Boiling latter part at 5 o'clock finished boiling washed off and on bent the mainsail stands Sat 18:36 Long

Wednesday first part pleasant course N.W. wind N.W. 16 bent the main sail main on bent the fore main and mizen topsail and bent the cat ones middle part latter part Mr Conant employed in fitting his Boat and others at work on the rigging scenes Sat 18:04

Thursday first part light air to the S course N.W. 17 at work on the rigging Mr Conant finished fitting his Boat and Painted her middle part
