February Monday the 27

first part pleasant middle squally and
rainy latter pleasant and fine breeze but
ahead and has been ever since we started
employed in mending the mainsail. found
Lat 34° 35' Long 179° 40' East. Day

Tuesday first part pleasant employed in mending
28 the mainsail middle latter fine breeze soends
Lat 34° 06' Long 179° 58'

Wednesday March the 28
first part fine breeze heading N by E
middle latter employed in scraping the
mast sauls Lat 34° 14' Long 179° 47' E.

Thursday first part Calm finished scraping the
2 waist middle fair wind for the first
time steering S by E latter employed in
various jobs at began to rain halled off
shore soends Lat 34° 56' Long

Friday first part squally and rainy one ship
3 in sight middle heavy squalls of wind
and rain from the N heading E by E
under double reefs latter moderate main
all sail soends Lat 34° 44' Long

Saturday first part light air on bent the
4 maintop galant sail and mended it in
ships in sight middle heavy squalls of
wind and rain from the Eastward heading
to the N by E under double reefs latter
more moderate wet held at 8 o'clock
kept off S by E and made all sail soends
at 11 o'clock saw the land Lat 35° 07'

Sunday first part afresh breeze steering
5 S by W wind & bent the Chains and got
the Anchors of the boats at 11 past 5
past Cape Breton and at 8 came to anchor
middle lying at an anchor latter at day
light took anchor and ran a short distance and
came to again soends

Monday first part pleasant took anchor and
6 ran a little farther let up hove up again and let up
again middle and latter hove up the anchor
again and took up 75 bbls of water and one
watch went on shore and the was employed
in painting and other jobs soends

Tuesday first part employed in sending in
7 and out rib and pluggil Booms and
getting some Iron work room soends one watch
on shore

Wednesday employed in Painting and one Watch
8 on shore soends

Thursday employed in Painting and sent a
9 raft of Caskoon shore and one watch on
liberty soends

Friday one watch on shore and the got off a raft
10 of water and some other jobs soends

Saturday wet hole and one Watch on liberty
11 and 2 of them took provisions liberty

Sunday at daylight 3 absconded in a Canoe
12 employed in stowing down water Painting
ing and got a raft of Caskoon on shore
soends

Monday one Watch on liberty getting off
13 water and Painting Caught one of
the deserters soends

Tuesday one Watch on liberty the other stow
14 ing down water and got a raft of
Caskoon on shore and filled them with
the girls and peaches are very plenty and cheap
for cash
