

Thursday August the 16th A.D. 1837
first part of fresh breeze N by N steering S by E
and at 7 o'clock clostreeped halled off shore with
the mainyard abaft. Tookanai bore S by E by S
distance about 15 miles middle lying aback latter
at 8 o'clock a canoe came alongside and 2 boats
went on shore and returned with 2 loads of
wood soends

Friday first pleasant got off 4 Boat loads of
17 wood middle lying off and on latter wood
soends

Saturday first part pleasant finished wooding got
18 in all 13 Boat loads middle rather rainy

steered N by N by N the course for
Chetiroa 2.2.2.4.5 Long 1.5.0.4.9 N by N latter
rather squally at 8 o'clock raised Chetiroa
and at 11 past 11 halled off soends

Sunday first part pleasant standing off and on
19 middle rockapoo latter 2 Boats on shore at
aidings on the E side wind hallying soends

Monday first part rather rainy 2 Boats
20 on shore at aidings got 29 Hogs 12 black
yams 4 hens and 12 bunches of bananas
saw 12 white shirts 2 pieces of white cotton
17 open handkerchiefs and 2 balls of Park wire
steering N by N wind S E latter steering
N by N wind E rather rainy soends
Lat 2.1.2.9 Long 1.5.3.1.2

Tuesday first part course N by N wind E & raining
21 middle latter at 6 o'clock saw Maria Island
and at 9 past it in the Lat 2.1.4.5 Long 1.5.3.1.0

Wednesday August the 22nd A.D. 1837
steered Maria and Mangera Island
Thursday first part fresh breeze N by E course
22 off for Mangera middle course N by E by S
fresh breeze latter employed in shipwreck
soends Lat 2.2.5.7 Long 1.5.4.9

Friday first part pleasant at 1 o'clock saw
23 Mangera and the wind halled N by N
and at 6 o'clock Mangera bore N by N by E
distance 20 miles middle and latter light air
Mangera in sight soends

Saturday first part slight breeze from the Northward
24 spook Capt Bell in the Panther and he was
on shore on Mangera and found it very rainy
and so we gave up our pursuit middle quite
steading whole weather middle and latter fair calm
there was no rain in it soends Lat 2.3.6

Sunday first part calm Capt Bell came on
25 board and got some Paint Oil middle
latter course N by N at 10 past 6 raised
the called Bevrotoona but what's for the
right name I don't now soends

Monday
26 first part steering N by N middle
lying off and on latter rainy soends
Tuesday first part rather rainy the 27
27 Boat went on shore and returning with
one Hog middle squally lying off and on
latter 2 Boats on shore soends

Wednesday first part fresh breeze and squally 3 Boats
28 on shore got 18 lbs of Potatoes 4 bags
13 pounds of Boar treads of Wood 50 bunches
of Bananas Capt Bray in the Becho
arising came there after bread middle
took in all to 2 o'clock reef main topsail
and steered N by N wind S E
