1 first part blowing agale reef topsail
bleas from the E middle and latter the same
sends Oct 21:54 Sings

Thursday first part agale from the E steering
2 to the S middle and latter rickapoo
sends Oct 23:54 Sings

Friday first part still agale to the East
3 middle latter more moderate set single
reefs at 11 o'clock saw large whale but
it being very rugged we saw him no
more sends Oct 23:47

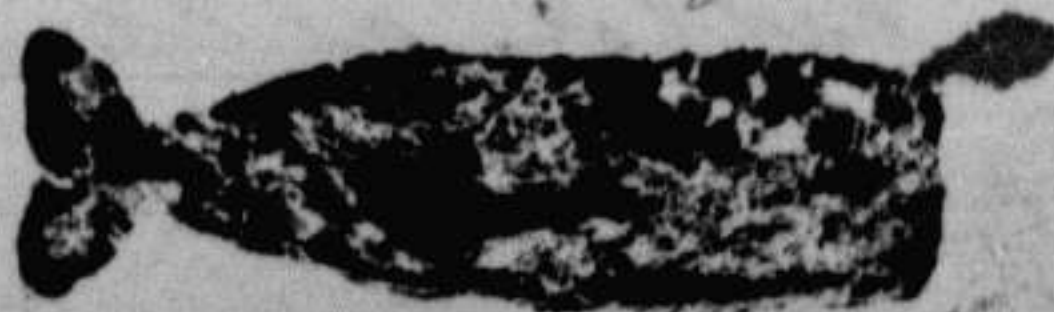
Saturday first part high winds and squally
4 from the East and Coast reefed the tops
ails middle and latter the same sends
Oct 23:31 Sings 171:21

Sunday first part agale from the E heading to
5 the S middle latter more moderate set
the topsails sends Oct 23:24 Sings 171:13

Monday first part of fine breeze E steering 11 middle
6 shortensail and halled to the head latter
the same sends Oct 23:22 Sings 171:42

Tuesday first part pleasant middle latter
7 at 9 o'clock raised a school of whales and
at 12 returned with 2 sends
Oct 23:55 Sings

Wednesday first part rather squally Cut in
8 the fish and at 5 o'clock began to Boil
middle employed in coiling latter finish
ed Boiling at 12 o'clock 2.8. bls
Oct 22:56 Sings 171:44



Thursday November the 9th 1837
first part of fresh breeze E steering 11
employed in clearing up the 11 middle
latter steering 11 at 11 o'clock saw breack
latter the 11 but saw its narrow sends
Oct 24:12 Sings

Friday first part pleasant and at 2 o'clock
10 raised 11 miles to windward and
lowered and at 3 o'clock struck and at 6
o'clock halled him along side middle 3.7 bls
latter calling all hands Oct 24:12 Sings
at 5 o'clock and at 6 o'clock
Cut one at 12 got the Case in good mend



Saturday first part of fresh breeze at 1 o'clock
11 began to Boil spoke the Atlantic Capt
Kendall 22 and 1250 bls middle and latter
Boiling sends

Sunday first part agale of wind to the E
12 Boiling under double reef main topsail
and foresail middle and latter the same
sends

Monday first part under double main top
13 sail and foresail at 3 o'clock finished
Boiling middle latter employed in breaking
out the Starboard side of the fore head
and stowing down sends

Tuesday first part blowing heavy and rain
14 employed in stowing down the Star
board side of the fore head of 100 bls
at night Cloastree the main topsail
and reefed the foresail middle latter rain
employed in regulating the Stowage sends

Wednesday first part blowing agale from the
15 E & heading S & rainey under cloast
reef main topsail and reef foresail middle
and latter blowing hard pulled the fore
it and rainey sends
