first part blowing half of gale from the Sth
heading S E set clost reef fore and mizen topsail
middle piled the fore and mizen topsail latter set them
again sends Sat 37:31 Long 173:24

Monday first part began to moderate employed in mak-
ing sail by the inches wind Sth heading S E
middle took it in by the boom latter agale
sends Sat 38:42 Long 174:51

Tuesday first part asqually from the Sth heading
19 S E set clostreefs and piled and set them
them again middle the same latter piled the fore
and mizen topsail sends Sat 39:42 Long 174:51

Wednesday first part blowing agale Sth heading
20 Sth wind as reef main topsail and reefersail
middle latter specially and rainey put up the
Springstays bent the Mainstaysail set it and piled
the foresail and hoisted the Bobs sends
Sat 40:12 Long 175:13

Thursday first part blowing agale Sth heading
21 S E under Clost reef main topsail and
Staysails middle latter more moderate made
Sail and Steered E by N on bent the foresail and
began to mend it sends Sat 40:30 Long 175:13

Friday first part alight breeze Nth Steering E by N
22 finished mending the foresail and bent it middle
Steered N E by E made sail and brought her to a clost
reef main topsail again latter agale sends
Sat 40:13 Long 175:36

Saturday first part more moderate Wind Sth heading
23 heading Nth middle made sail latter wind
Nth heading Sth on bent the Main topsail
and bent anemone sends Sat 39:38 Long 175:36

Sunday first part
24 afresh breeze Nth heading Sth employed
in mending the maintopgallant sail middle and
latter squally and rainey sends Sat 40:06 Long 174:02

Monday December the 25th 1837
first part afresh breeze from the Westward double
reef the topsails piled the Jib. Mainsail and Stay-
sails middle Clost reefed latter piled the fore
and mizen topsail and reefed the foresail heavy gust
of wind and rain send

Tuesday first part wind Sth heading under 3 reef main
25 topsail and Stay-sail middle latter started water
set clostreefs sends Sat 39:14 Long 174:51

Wednesday first part wind Sth set double reef middle
27 made allsail latter Sth heading Sth
employed in making Springyarn sends Sat 37:41 Long 175:13

Thursday first part pleasant alight breeze S E heading
28 Sth employed in making Springyarn middle
latter employed in mending the maintopsail sends
Sat 38:40 Long 175:13

Friday first part fine breeze N E Steering S
29 finished mending the main topsail and at
4 o'clock Nth lowered after blackish and at 12
last 5 returned with 4 and struck 2 more but
drove from them middle latter Boiled out the
Black Fish amounting to 160 galls sends
Sat 39:40 Long 175:36

Saturday first part afresh breeze N Steering
30 S employed in making Springyarn
middle latter employed in beating off rust
and blacking. Trans inboard and rove new
foretopsail Brantlines send Sat 41:25 Long 175:36

Sunday first part afresh breeze N by E
31 Course Sth at 5 o'clock it blew fair
for a dirty Norther puffd to the Westward
under a 3 reef Main topsail and fore top-
sail Staysail middle rainey latter making
sail by the inches sends Sat 42:18 Long 174:02
