

At Right Whaling on New Zealand

Thursday January the 11th 1838
first part a gale of wind from the Southward
employed in mincing the blubber and stowing
down below again middle the same latter at 8
o'clock began to Boil again send Sat 45' 04
Song

Friday first part employed in Boiling rather rainy
12 middle and latter the same at 10 o'clock fin
ished Boiling 85 blbls send 5 or 6 Ships in
sight

Saturday first part set all sail employed in
13 Coopering at 7 Coast reefed middle latter
began to lash out the after hoist in order to stow
but lowered and chased Whales 1 hour before breakfast
there Whales in sight but it being rather rainy and
blower we did not lower again sends

Sunday first part about 12th heading S E
14 employed in stowing oil down aft to the amount
of 80 blbls of Whale oil middle latter employed
in stowing down empty tank at 6 lowered and stow
ed a Whale and at 11 returned with him
and began to Cut sends
S B 15 blbls



Monday first part pleasant 12 lowered and at
15 1/2 past 3 returned with 1 and at 4 began to
Cut and at 7 finished middle 5 Ships in sight
at 9 o'clock began to Boil latter the same sends
Sat 45' 150 Song

Tuesday first part pleasant heading N 1/2 W
16 S B employed in Boiling saw Capt
Picken in the Baltic Catch a Whale mid
at 3 finished Boiling latter at 6 lower and
struck a scrag and he upset the Boat and
waxed off with the sick of 1 Live and 2 Dons

Wednesday January the 16th 1838
and 1st Grade cut at 10 past 9 lowered again
and at 11 hallooed a chap alongside sends
S B 60 blbls



Thursday first part pleasant at 10 past 3 finished
17 Cutings and at 4 began to Boil 2 Ships
in sight middle latter employed in Boiling and
stowing Oil down in the Brin send Sat
S B 12 blbls

S B 65 blbls



Friday first part
18 pleasant employed in Boiling and stowing
down Oil in the Brin raised a Whale at 3
lowered and at 5 hallooed him alongside and 1/2 past
7 finished Cutings middle latter spoke the Cussy
of Harver 1.5 mo 1050 blbls of Whale oil
she had a whale along and this aboiling it is very
foggy we are employed in Boiling and Break
ing the Starboard side of the after hoist
sends

Saturday first part light air and thick fog
19 stowed 60 blbls of Oil and kept the fires
agoing at night the weather looked rather
unfavourable and we took in to double reef
main top sail middle at 4 finished Boiling
latter stowed down 30 blbls making in all
230 blbls sends Sat Song

Sunday first part rather rugged employed in
20 regulating a few things fore and aft and
washed off middle latter blowing a gale from
the Southward took in the Bow Boat and repaired
her chocks where the scrag hit her with his
fin and rowed her over employed in
scraping Boam sends Sat Song
