

• 1 Bright Whaling on New Zealand
 Sunday January the 21st 1838
 first part blowing agale from the Southward
 heading to the Westward employed in scraping. Began
 at night wore ship. Last reefer the Maintopsail
 and reefer the foresail right. Whales in sight middle
 letter rather more moderate chased awhile but with
 success seen. Sat 45:57 Song 179:04

Monday first part rather squally caught a whale
 2.2 and cut nine in spoke the Ship. Corinthian
 of Bristol Cpt Gardner 12 ms 1100 blbls
 Whaleoil middle letter calm employed in scrape
 ing. Began seen. Sat 45:57 Song 179:04

Tuesday first part Calm employed in scraping
 2.3. Began and setting up Shooks at 6 o'clock began
 to boil middle letter lowered after a scrag but
 soon gave up the chase employed in Boiling
 seen. Sat 45:57 Song 179:04

Wednesday first part employed in Boiling at 12
 2.4 lowered after a whale but he smelt the rat
 and turned his nose to windward and was off
 at 3 lowered again and in the space of 15 ms
 the fog made its appearance and we was glad to
 return and bring the Ship to a 3 reef Maintopsail
 for by that time there was something of a
 breeze from the S. S. W. at 4 finished Boiling
 middle letter rather more moderate set double
 reefs lowered 3 different times struck 1 and the
 other times they were scrag or else we could not
 catch them for it was very rugged and squally
 seen. Sat 45:54 Song 179:57

Thursday first part a plenty of Whales in
 2.5 sight but it was rugged too lower the
 wind being S accompanied by squalls off
 rain & Ships in sight of them
 Boiling

Thursday January the 25th 1838
 middle letter agale of wind and rain storm employ
 ed in breaking out the after head and stowing
 down the scannels Oil & Ships in sight
 seen. Sat 45:57 Song 179:04

Friday first part agale from the Southward
 2.6 finished stowing down and hoisted out
 the Pumps for they were foul and then
 scraped and washed off middle letter at sun
 rise more moderate set double reefs but soon brought her
 to a close reef Maintopsail and turned up the Bore
 Is seen. Sat 46:10 Song 179:45

Saturday first part blowing from S. W. lying
 2.7 under a 3 reef Maintopsail and Staysails
 the Corinthian in sight middle letter more
 moderate but unsettled set double reefs sent
 down the fore and mizen top galant yards
 and masts and other Tails seen. Sat 45:57 Song 179:04

Sunday first part a fresh breeze and rather squa
 2.8 ly spoke the Corinthian Cpt Gardner
 12 ms 1300 Whaleoil and the Baltic
 Cpt Green 28 ms 1500 in the meantime
 raised Whales and lowered but they being
 bound too windward we soon gave up the chase
 middle letter at 8 raised whales and lowered and at
 11 haled 1 alongside and began to Cut seen
 Sat 45:57 Song 179:04

Monday 2.9 first part rather rugged at 2 finished
 Cutting and at 3 lowered and struck and she
 started to windward and at 4 her nose heeled
 and in part 7 turned up and at 8 haled her
 alongside at 4 began to boil middle part
 squally letter at 11 part 4 called the watch
 and hooked on part of the pin Chain and gave
 the ship Cutting but still a Boiling seen
