

A Right Whaling on New Zealand D 1838  
Sturday February the 10<sup>th</sup>

first art. afresh. breas finished stowings down 80  
bbls of Whaloe middle heavy squalls of wind and rain  
the staysail sheet onhooked and slab it rather late  
latter onlent repaired and lent it again sounds

Sat 45:47 Song 178:40

Sunday first part heavy squalls of wind and  
11 rain accompanied with hail from the S  
middle latter it came on to agale lying under  
a 3 reef maintopsail and foresail reefed down S off

Monday first part blowing agale from the S off lying  
12 under a 3 reef maintopsail middle and latter  
all sails sounds Sat Song

Tuesday first part blowing agale S off set areef  
13 foresail main and mizen staysail middle  
latter more moderate set all sail employed in  
ships duty. sounds Sat 45:44 Song 179:20

Wednesday first part light airs S a heavy swell down  
14 ing and foggy. rose new main topsail braces  
and other joles middle latter alight breas  
stowings S off employed in regulating shoos & hook  
heads whale boat and emptying that came to hook  
sounds Sat 43:59 Song 179:32 E

Thursday first part alight breas S off steering S off  
15 employed in drying. boat and several other joles  
middle latter rather foggy. employed in scraping  
Boat sounds

Friday first part afresh breas and rainey split the  
16 file joined the fore and mizen topsail wind S  
middle latter calm saw whales and at 9 lowered  
struck 2 and stowed them sounds

Saturday first part calm at 4 o'clock lowered struck  
17 one and he saved the 3 carried off 8 Signs 1 lance  
and 430 fathom of line

Saturday February the 17<sup>th</sup> D 1838  
middle latter afresh breas N steering S off  
sounds Sat 44:47

Sunday first part blowing 22 of agale N steering  
18 S off under double reef at night kept to  
on the Western tack and took in to a 3 reef  
Maintopsail middle latter high winds and foggy  
at 11 raised a whale and at 12 lowered sounds

Monday first part afresh breas but rather of a heavy  
19 swell at 3 returned with him and began to  
cut lowered 2 boats and chased 2 hovers with  
cut success at 7 finished cutting middle at  
8 began to coil latter employed in boiling. light rather  
foggy. sounds Sat 45:28 Song 178:45 E S 15:45

Tuesday  
20 first part alight breas S off and foggy employed  
in boiling middle latter at 7 finished boiling and  
at 11 part 1 lowered and at 10 halled her along side  
and began to cut but before we halled her along side  
she layed her head on the Starboard boat which cut  
her to the waters edge and from there to the keel  
sounds Sat 45:45 Song

Wednesday first part pleasant at 1 finished cutting  
21 and at 4 began to boil middle and latter rainey  
employed in boiling saw whales but the weather  
was not fit to lower sounds Sat Song 178:55 E

Thursday first part wind E and  
22 foggy employed in boiling. Water off 25 bbls  
out of the after hold and starting it in to  
small Casks and put ing it betwixt decks  
at 3 finished boiling middle latter pleasant  
employed in breaking out the after hold and  
stowings down oil sounds Sat

Friday first part pleasant slight breas E finished  
23 breaking out the after hold and stowing  
down 137 bbls of Whale Oil which  
off the ground middle
