

New Zealand Monday March the 19<sup>th</sup> 1838  
first part pleasant wind N and that for the course  
there was 14 of them for we had not anything else to do  
middle latter employed in salting Boon encumbered of whales  
insight at 11 lowered and at 12 returned without success  
saw 5000

Tuesday first part fresh breeze to the Northward at 4  
20 o'clock lowered 2 boats and at 12 part 6 hauled her  
alongside after along and tiquis job middle latter  
latter at daylight called allhands and began  
to cut it being rugged and rainy we lost the anchor  
parted guys and twice and at 11 got the body  
in sound 55 lbs

Wednesday first part slight breeze N until  
21 6 when it cleared and we began to boil middle  
and latter foggy employed in boiling sound

Thursday first part wind S S E and foggy employed in  
12 boiling middle at 2 finished boiling latter foggy  
employed in breaking out and regulating shoes and

Friday first part slight breeze N N E and thick foggy  
23 regulating shoes 1 whale came playing round  
middle latter employed in cleaning boat at 10 lowered 2 boats  
struck killer and sunk one sound Sat 44:35 Song

Saturday first part rather foggy but it lighted a little and we  
24 lowered and struck and got the Starboard boat stove  
and just as we had tamed him it came up a thick fog  
and we had to cut and let him go middle with the  
2 whales went 80 fathoms of line 6 irons and 1 lance  
middle it came on to blow and rain at 12 part 1 called  
allhands turned up the Boats and brought her to aid  
reep maintop sail latter it still increased at 10 ship  
filled the Bowboat and broke the foreward davy but  
we had 2 holes aloft and hooked on to her and saved  
the best part of her sound Sat 85 lbs



Sunday March the 25<sup>th</sup> 1838  
first part blowing equal S S E foggy and rainy lying  
under a 3 reef maintop sail middle latter rather more moderate  
steered her N E by N for the bay of islands set reef  
fore sail last reef fore top sail and double reef Maintop sail  
sound

Monday first part high winds S S E course N E by N  
26 set a single reef maintop sail and whole Mates middle  
latter employed in mending the Starboard Boat cleaning boat  
and other jobs sound Sat 44:45 Song

Tuesday first part fresh breeze S S W and low day employed  
27 in mending the boat scraping boat and bent  
anew fore sail course N N W middle latter employed  
in coping stowing down and mending the Boat sound  
Sat 40:59 Song

Wednesday first part pleasant diminished stowing down  
28 70 lbs and other jobs spoke apprehend ship from  
Harver 1200 lbs 9 months out by the name  
of Angelina Capt Suice middle latter allhand  
employed in putting on new ringstoppers rather rainy  
sound Sat 40:59 Song

Thursday first part part slight breeze E and rainy  
29 George V middle latter wind S E course N by N  
allhands employed in cleaning ship sound  
Sat 38:49 Song

Friday first part slight breeze S S E course N by N  
30 allhands employed in cleaning ship middle  
it came on to blow and rain last reef the fore and  
mizen top sail and turned up the 2 Boats latter  
kept her N N W and made all sail rainy and  
rather squally sound Sat 36:47 Song 179:09 E

Saturday first part fresh breeze E S E course  
31 179:30 N middle latter employed in drying the  
last of our boat sound Sat 35:47  
Song 176:41 E
