Monday first part afresh breeze S E heading N E
14 employed in repairing the Boat middle
latter afresh breeze and rugged at 9 raised a school of whales
and at 10 past 9 lowered and chased until we was
tired and then we let them lie to grab set out
K to return but on passage we met another
school and set off in pursuit of them sends

Tuesday first part high winds the boats in chase of
15 Whales until 2 o'clock when left them without
success returned onboard spoke the Ship Atlantic
and found that she had got 1200 blb whale middle
latter employed in mending the Boat and rattling
down the maintopmast rigging and other jobs
sends

16 the Boat and other jobs spoke the Ship
Corinthian of Bristol R S Capt Gardner
middle latter mending the Boat and foretopsail
