Tuesday first part pleasant, fine breeze E N & heavy
26 S & finished mending the main topsail middle
and later high winds N E covers S & E rather rainy
employed in halling up the sheathing and washing
it. Spoke the Navy Capt Brock soon.

Wednesday first part high winds N E & rain
27 and rainy. Course S & E employed in washing
the deck where the sheathing was taken up
at night coast reefed and kept her going
middle squally and b'ling later rather wind N E
or squally employed in scrubbing decks soon.

Thursday first part fresh breeze off one heavy squalls
28 took in to a double reef main topsail and fore
sail and at 12 o'clock kept her off E N E and at
3 o'clock it became astoey breeze set a whole main tops
and coast reef fore topsail an whole watches middle
and later course E by E employed in odd jobs soon.

Friday first part fresh breeze off course E by N
29 employed in odd jobs middle rather squally
later employed in drawing and knotting yarns

being large enough middle and later the
wind from W to N employed in make
ing spun yarn soon. Sat 27:18

Sunday July the 1st D. 1838
first part pleasant fine breeze N off employed
in building a blacksmiths Shop and some other
small jobs middle later course N E by E thick
weather but amoderate breeze soon. Sat and got
Song all day

Monday first part rather rainy with a light
2 N by off course N E by E middle and later
rainy and squally reeled the fore top sail soon.
Sat

Tuesday first part commenced with another and rainy
3 at 8 o'clock called out to the S off course
N E by E turned the heads of the fore top sail
middle and later light breeze S off employed in
blacksmithing and other jobs soon.

Sat 26:37 Song 165:32
Wednesday first part pleasant slight breeze S
4 off course N E by E employed in black
smithing and knotting yarns middle course
N E later fresh breezes and squally employed in
making spun yarn and reverts soon.

Sat 25:32 Song 164:45
Thursday first part fresh breeze S off course
5 N E by E quite standing whole water
is employed in making spun yarn and
reverts middle and later high winds employed in
odd jobs soon. Sat 25:32 Song

Friday first part pleasant with slight breeze S
6 course N E by E employed in making reverts
and other jobs middle later repaired the main
topsail sheats and some other jobs soon.

Saturday first part slight S off course N
7 E later by fore top sail sheats and some
other jobs middle later at 6 o'clock raised
changed at distance of 15 miles being N by
E and at 11 o'clock off shore it being there
sunday we could not trade soon.
