This 24 hours fine gales and pleasant
Weather at 8 am saugh a Schooner
a steering W. the Watch was imployed
at various jobs so ends

Remarks on Saturday the 4 Day
This 24 hours fresh gales and squally
Made and shortened sail occasionally ends
Lat 24° 50' N long 88° 30'

Remarks on Sunday October the 5 Day
This 24 hours fresh gales and rainers at 10 am
We had a very heavy squall from the
S.E. took in the main topgallant sail
and reefed the topsails and the gibe at
11 am had a rather squall then took
in the fore and mizen top sails and at
6 am moderated and then made sail ends
Lat 19° 53' N long 29° 55'

Remarks on Monday October the 6 Day
This 24 hours light winds from the East at
6 pm took ship to the S.E. the Watch was
imployed at various jobs so ends Lat 19° 20' long 29° 43'

Remarks on Tuesday October the 7 Day
This 24 hours light winds and pleasant weather
Made and shortened sail occasionally
The Watch was imployed at various jobs so ends
Lat 19° 59' N long 29° 45'

Remarks on Wednesday October the 8 Day
This 24 hours light winds from the East and
pleasant weather the Watch imployed at various
jobs and shortened sail occasionally so ends
Thursday Lat 20° 08' long 29° 45'

Remarks on Thursday October the 9 Day
This 24 hours light winds and pleasant weather
Made and shortened sail occasionally at 6 am
saw a ship to the N.W. but did not
speak her at 11 am took ship to the S.E. so ends
Lat 19° 05' long 27° 14'

Remarks on Friday October the 10 Day
This 24 hours light winds and sail at 11 am
Took a boat from the S.E. square
and got the main voyage out and made
shorten sail and fore throat so ends
the Watch imployed at various jobs so ends
Lat 18° 53' long 27° 14'

Remarks on Saturday October the 11 Day
This 24 hours fine gales and pleasant weather
at 11 am saugh a sail a head of the ship
Lat 18° 05' long 27° 14'

Remarks on Sunday October the 12 Day
This 24 hours fresh gales from the N.W. at 3 pm
The light sails at 3 pm saugh a sail
but they was hump backs at 6 am
and hence the heads yards - backs at 4 am
yards and kept them up 330 at 6 am
made the land once again so ends
Lat 17° 48' long 25° 20'
