Remarks on Sunday November the 23rd day
First part Buzes and Cold Weather and
Strong breezes Saw nothing remarkable
The Later part Calm at meridian
Sounded we was in 53 fathoms of
Water and so ~~by compass~~ ends Course 4th
Lat by obs 40°10' Long 55°50'

Remarks on Monday November the 24th day
First part Light Winds from the
Southwest the middle and latter part
The same at 4 am Sounded and found
60 fathoms of water saw porpoises
Phocaenae and eight whales all hands
employed in skinning out water
And trimming the ship and course 4th
By compass and so ends

Lat by obs 41°28' Long 57°10'
Remarks on Tuesday November the 25th day
First part and middle part light winds
From the NW Saw nothing remarkable
latter part Strong breezes Course
SSW By compass and so ends
Lat by obs 43°02' Long 59°02'

From New Bedford Round A Round Cape
Remarks on Wednesday November the 26th
First part Strong breezes from the S by
Compass 4 by W by compass took in the two
quartering boats and at 10 am sent down
the fore and main topgallant yards and
Masts and saved off the main rigging
Mast and Ends with some rain and
One and half of our Calm

Lat by Ir 45°43' Long 60°36'
Remarks on Thursday November the 27th
First part Calm and foggy untill the
Sun kind shifted to Eastward and back again
To the NW and thunder and lightning then
Strong breezes and so ends shaped a course to far
dist 3rd 37 m Lat by obs 46°20' Long 61°15'

Remarks on Friday November the 28th
Strong winds and foggy and at 4 pm
Shaped a Course to the northwestern
island and the distance was 280 miles
Course S 2 W made and shortened sail so
Casualty and bent the storm stay sail
and so ends with the winds to the S W
untill 11 am and halled to the S W 200 m
Lat 48°36' by Ir Long 61°42' by lunar

Remarks on Saturday November the 29th day
First and Middle part light winds from
the NW at 6 pm Spoke the ship Canton
of New Bedford with 150 Barrels of oyl from
Cape Horn the abraham garden Cart and
latter part Strong breezes from the SE Course
S 2 W by W 4 W by compass spoke the Canton and the light
Canton on board and so ends by lunar 63°45'
Lat by obs 47°57' Long
