Morning at 6 am loosed the boats and got two black
fish and the Canton got 3 more seals

Lat 22 20 S long 70 48 by lunar
Remarks on Monday January the 12 Day in the year 1852
First and middle part fresh gales from the SE the latter
part the same got a sunfish and saw some more seals
In company with the Canton made and shortened sail
every night and morning so ends

Lat 20 9 S long
Remarks on Tuesday January the 13 Day first and
Middle part light winds from the S the last part
The same the Canton got another blackfish and
Finished trying and so did we and commenced
Work on the rigging setting and watching it down
to 6 am got a sunfish so ends

Lat 20 S long
Remarks on Wednesday 14 January the 14 Day
First and middle part light winds the latter part
Strong winds from the S we was in company
With the Canton the whale was employed to work
On the rigging so ends

Lat 19 30 S long
Remarks on Thursday January the 15 Day First part
Strong gales and so ends the same at 4 pm loosed the
Boats and got three blackfish the Canton got one more
and so ends With fine winds and pleasant weather

Lat 19 27 S long
Remarks on Friday January the 16 Day this 24
Hours light gales and pleasant weather at 6 pm the
Waste boat got one blackfish was in company with
The Canton so ends

Light winds and pleasant weather was employed at
Work on the rigging saw nothing but phinbacks and
Was in company with the Canton so ends

Middle part pleasant gales and weather saw nothing
Remarkable but caught one sunfish and some dolphins
the latter part the same as the middle was in company
With the Canton so ends

Lat 17 20 S long
Remarks on Monday January the 19 Day first
and middle part light winds the latter part strong
Winds from the SE at meridian we and the Canton
loosed the boats and the Starboard and larboard boats
Got some small Whales and the larboard boat got
Stove but we saved the Whale and put him in
and got plenty of dolphin so ends

Remarks on Tuesday January the 20 Day this 24 hours
Strong winds from the West and pleasant weather we
Commenced trying at 6 am and got done at mid
night but the Canton had not got done employ
At mending boats and so ends

Lat long
Remarks on Wednesday January the 21 Day fresh gales
and pleasant weather saw some humphacks and phin
backs but no sperm Whales was in company with the
Canton Course S W so ends

Lat long 76 W
Remarks on Thursday January the 22 Day this 24 hours
Strong winds from S was in company with the Canton
Saw plenty of phinbacks and humphacks and some
small fish and so ends

Lat 15 33 S long 77 W
