Remarks on Friday January the 23 day
This 24 hours fresh gales and pleasant weather
Saw no Whales but saw some fish
Company with the Canton so ends
lat 14 30 long 78 30

Remarks on Saturday January the 24 day
This 24 hours strong winds from the SE and pleasant
Weather saw no Whales but a plenty of small fish
Was in Company with the Canton so ends
lat long 79 25

Remarks on Sunday January the 25 day
This 24 hours fresh gales from the SE and pleasant
Weather saw nothing but phinbacks and small fish
Was in Company with the Canton made and
Shortened sail every 4 hours night and morning
Went on board of the Canton so ends
lat 13 20 long

Remarks on Monday January the 26 day
This 24 hours fresh gales from the SE saw
Nothing Remarkable Was in Company with
the Canton so ends
lat long

Remarks on Tuesday January the 27 day
This 24 hours fresh gales from the SE saw nothing
of any Whales but was in Company with the Canton
Caught some fish and so ends
lat long

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Remarks on Wednesday the 28 day of January this 24
Hours fresh gales and pleasant weather at 7 a.m. the
Canton landed and got in Whales and at 3 p.m. the boat
And there was a plenty the Whales and Starboard boats
Got fast and so ends with plenty of Whales
lat long

Remarks on Thursday January the 29 day the first
Part of this 24 hours fresh gales and pleasant weather at
4 p.m. the starboard boat got one Whale and saw
Plenty more at 9 a.m. but then it began to
Boil in Company with the Canton so ends
lat 09 00 long

Remarks on Friday January the 30 day
All of this 24 hours light winds from the SE and
A plenty of black fish and brown backs was in Company
With the Canton at meridian finished day's work so ends
lat 06 00 long

Remarks on Saturday January the 31 day
All of this 24 hours light winds and variable all hands
Employed at stowing oil in Company with the Canton
A small Schooner from Nantux did not speaken at 11 a.m. spoke
A small Schooner from Nantux so ends

Remarks on Sunday February the 1 day all of this 24 hours
Fair gales and pleasant weather at 8 p.m. let go our anchor and
Sailed at 9 p.m. the Canton came in and the ship united
States of Baltimore here and the ship lived of Nantux
and several small sails at 1 p.m. the Starboard Watch
Went on shore on liberty so ends

Remarks on Monday February the 2 day all of this 24 hours
Pleasant weather one Whith a shore on liberty and the other
was played at painting Ship at 11 a.m. the ship taken
Came in sight and sent her boat a shore so ends
