All of this 24 hours fine weather at 8 am
Boat went to Calan after some goats
At 12 am the boat returned with 8 goats
one with a shorn on liberty so ends

Remarks on Thursday February the 5 day
All this 24 hours fine weather all hands in
played at ships duty at 9 am the ship
Equator came in the mouth of the river and
from near headland with 2500 lbs of oil
so ends

Remarks on Friday February the 6 day
All of this 24 hours moderate weather all
hands in played at boat ing off potatoes
and pumpkins at 9 am 4 boats came went
on board of the regatta states of Northampton and
hadred them get up her inakes and had her
got under way she was bound to young quill Bay
so ends

Remarks on Saturday February the 7 day
All of this 24 hours fresh gales and variable at
3 pm took our anchor and the Canton parted
her cable and lost her anchor at 4 pm the
shaped our course for Tomboes in company
with the Canton at 5 pm caught a haul of
fish called the halibut and at 10 am came
the ship Phoenix of Manchester 25 months
out with 24 hundred lb of oil and the
Canton got an anchor out of her the day
two sails but did not speak them so ends
Lat 48

Remarks on Sunday February the 8 day
All of this 24 hours light winds from the S at
3 pm left the ship Phoenix she was bound to
Porto the men down the land for Tomboes in
company with the Canton at 11 am came a brig
steering to the Westward on the Wind so ends
Lat 20 40 S

Remarks on Monday February the 9 day all of
this 24 hours fine gales from the N at 11 am came
to anchor at Tomboes bay in company with the
Canton so ends

Remarks on Tuesday February the 10 day all of
this 24 hours fine weather caught a small sloop
Did not speak her at 2 pm sent 2 boats a shore
with 1 a raft for the Canton so ends

Remarks on Wednesday February the 11 day all of
this 24 hours fine weather at 8 pm got our baskets
filled with Mackerel and anchored them in the river
at 5 pm went with three boats after them and got
in the day and was a blight to leave them there
until high water so ends

Remarks on Thursday February the 12 day all of
this 24 hours fine weather at 5 am the boats went
after the raft but could not find it at 6 am
caught a sail and it was a Spanish vessel bound to
young quill and she sent her boat on board of the
Canton so ends

Remarks on Friday February the 13 day
All of this 24 hours fine weather all hands in
in getting off the Canton and towing it so ends

Remarks on Saturday February the 14 day all of
this 24 hours fine gales and variable at 4 pm got
the ship Phoenix of Manchester at 8 pm took our anchor and
went to sea in company with the Canton so ends
