from the S. W. at 4 p.m. caught a large school of Whales bound
to the S. E. lowered the boat and got one while the landward
boat got three took him a long side and at 7 a.m.
began to cut and steam began to boil Made and Shortened
Sail occasionally So Ends Lat 32° 33' N Long 176° 44' W

Remarks on *Saturday* July 26th This 24 hours
light winds and calm at 11 a.m. got three
at boiling caught a plenty of porpoises and
black fish Made from the S. S. W. Made
and Shortened Sail occasionally So Ends
Lat 32° 18' N

Remarks on *Sunday* July 27th This 24 hours fine
gales from the S. W. caught porpoises and
jumped and So Ends Lat 31° 44' N

Remarks on *Tuesday* July 28th This 24 hours fresh
breezes from the S. W. caught porpoises and plenty
of small fish Made and Shortened Sail
occasionally So Ends Lat 31° 06' N Long 174° 00' W

Remarks on *Wednesday* July 29th This 24 hours
fresh breezes from the S. E. by E at 6 a.m. began to
stave down and at 9 a.m. caught a large whale
one point off of the Weather bow bound to the Weather
Made and Shortened Sail occasionally
So Ends Lat 31° 20' N Long 174° 10' W

Remarks on *Thursday* July 30th This 24 hours fresh breezes
from the S. E. caught a whale and lost him put
did not get him and at 4 a.m. caught a large school
lowered but we lost the bow of three Went aboard
and caught a rather school bound to the S. W.
Lowered at 10 a.m. and the Starboard boat got fast
to a small whale but did not get him Deadfall
till the next 24 hours at 8 p.m. So Ends
Lat 30° 30' N Long 173° 30' W

Remarks on *Friday* July 31st This 24 hours fresh breeze
from the S. E. at 5 p.m. got the whale cut in and at 8 a.m.
caught another school bound to the W. S. W. lowered
and fastened the to 8 but the iron broke and failed
but the whale boat got 1 small whale So Ends
Lat 30° 15' N Long 173° 15' W

Remarks on *Saturday* August 1st This 24 hours fresh
gales from the E at 4 a.m. got three a hailing and
cleared up the decks Made and Shortened Sail
occasionally So Ends Lat 31° 20' N

Remarks on *Sunday* August 2nd This 24 hours
fresh breezes and squally weather Wind from the
S. Made and Shortened Sail occasionally So Ends
Lat 31° 00' N

Remarks on *Monday* August 3rd This 24 hours strong
gales and squally weather Wind from the S. E. and a
plenty of rain took in the topgallant sails and gaff and
spraken and split the main sail then furled it and two
reefed the topbails fore and aft and set the main stay
Sail So Ends Lat 30° 30' N
