Remarks on Saturday March 14 this 24 hours
Sight Wind and pleasant weather at 5 am the
Ship came to anchor at Macao bar in Company
with the Columbus and at 4 am the Captain took
Course West or Shore on Liberty So Ends

Remarks on Sunday March 15 this 24 hours
Sight Wind and Calm at 6 am took our anchor
from Macao bar and Steered S by W in Company
with the Columbus So Ends

Remarks on Monday March 16 this 24 hours
Fresh breeze from the S by E Course Steered
by Compass S W Nothing more remarkable the
Columbus in Company So Ends

Remarks on Tuesday March 17 this 24 hours
Fresh breeze from the S Course by Compass S W
Nothing but small fish in Company
with the Columbus So Ends

Remarks on Wednesday March 18 this 24 hours
Strong Trade and rain weather all hands employed
in various jobs in Company with the Columbus
Course Steered by Compass W by S So Ends

Remarks on Thursday March 19 this 24 hours
Strong breeze from the E and rain weather
Course Steered by Compass W by S in Company
with the Columbus So Ends

Remarks on Friday March 20 this 24 hours
Fresh breeze from the E Course W in Company
with the Columbus at 6 am took in Sail at 6 am
Made Sail So Ends

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Remarks on Saturday March 14 this 24 hours
Fresh breeze from the E and rain weather
Made and Shortened Sail occasion
by Course Steered by Compass W in
Company with the Columbus Sailed
Nothing So Ends Lat 18° 8' Long 169° 43' W

Remarks on Sunday March 15 this 24 hours
Fresh breeze from the E and pleasant weather
Sailed Nothing but small fish took in Sail
Nothing and Made Sail in the morning in Company
with the Columbus So Ends

Remarks on Monday March 16 this 24 hours
Strong gales and fresh Course Steered S W by
Compass Sailed small fish in Company with
the Columbus So Ends Lat 20° 10' S

Remarks on Tuesday March 17 this 24 hours
Fresh gales from the S E and pleasant weather the
Shortened Sail at night and cutted up the top sails
in Company with the Columbus Course S W Sailed
Small fish So Ends

Remarks on Wednesday March 18 this 24 hours
Fresh gales from the S E Course S W
Sailed black fish and porpoises in
Company with the Columbus Made and
Shortened Every night and Morning
So Ends Lat 21° 5' S Long 174° 45' W
