Remarks on Saturday April 10 this 24 hours
Strong gales at 6 am Capt bore off S.W. till
11 pm then bore to heading to the S. Winds to the
S.E. So birds but long

Remarks on Sunday April 11 this 24 hours
Pleasant Weather Winds from the S.E. at meridian
colored and got 2 Small Whales and take them along
side and began to cut its hide but 2.500 long long 17.50

Remarks on Monday April 12 this 24 hours employed
the first part in cutting at 9 pm got three and at 6 am
baggy to sail and at 11 am saw a rather small
Whale chased and the bag was to take
So birds but long 17.50 East

Remarks on Friday April 16 this 24 hours pleasant
breezes from the S.E. at 6 pm bore the Ship to
A heading to the S. and at 6 am made Sail the Watch
employed in breaking out between decks for
Cooks So birds lat long

Remarks on Saturday April 17 this 24 hours
Winds from the S and pleasant Weather Saw 4
phinbacks and porpoises the Watch employed in
various jobs So birds

Remarks on Sunday April 18 this 24 hours
Pleasant breezes from the S. Saw 4 phinbacks
Made and Shortened Sail Occasionally
So birds

Remarks on Monday April 19 this 24 hours
Pleasant Weather Saw 4 Whales bore to the S.W.
but we did not get to them before sunset and then
took in Sail So birds lat 28.28 N long 16.50 East
