got down a hauling down and cleaned up
the decks So ends

Remarks on Saturday July 17 this 24 hours
light breeze and pleasant at 5 p.m. spoke
the hope Chaddock of New Bedford 21 months
out with 400 bbls So ends

Remarks on Sunday July 18 this 24 hours
light breeze and pleasant at 9 a.m. spoke the
Ship James Russell of Nantucket 25 months
out with 2000 bbls of oil saw nothing
but small fish So ends

Remarks on Monday July 19 this 24 hours
light breeze and calm at 4 p.m. spoke the
Ship Russell of Nantucket 25 months out
with 1700 bbls of oil and spoke the fortune
a gain So ends Lat 31 56 N long

Tuesday July 20 this 24 hours
light breeze and morning saw a ship
to leeward saw plenty of whales but
got none So ends Lat 31 30 N long 169 00 E

Remarks on Wednesday July 21 this 24 hours
the first part raining and squally the latter
part pleasant and plenty of whales at 6 a.m.
lowered and chased till 5 p.m. and struck
and got the whale a long side at 11 p.m.
So ends Lat 31 40 N long 169 00 East

Remarks on Thursday July 22 this 24 hours
light breeze and the first part pleasant the latter
part raining at 5 a.m. began to hunt and got him
in at meridian So ends Lat 31 55 N long 169 20 E
