

Ships Seen When in the Richmond 1899

Wednesday Feb 11 there was a Spanish
Man of War brig came in to Ensenada and
sent a boat with on board of the Captain
and three was bound to Guayaquil

Monday Feb 14 at 10 am spoke the
Ship Minerva Chase of New Bedford 2 1/2
Months out with 500 blks of oil but 2,000 lbs

Monday Feb 19 at 8 pm spoke the
Ship Triton Chase of New Bedford 7 Months
out with 350 blks oil but 3,000 lbs

Saturday Feb 22 at 4 pm Sailed
Ensenada to the Mindanao

Sunday May 31 at 5 pm spoke the
Ship Friedrich Augustus Carl of Newport
2 1/2 Months out with 1400 blks of oil but 32,000 lbs

Sunday June 4 Sailed a Ship to Mindanao
Did not speak there but 32,000 lbs

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Monday June the 8 day
this day at 3 PM spoke the
Ship Eagle of Warrington
6 Months out with 300 blks
Long 157-00 Lat 30-30

Friday June the 12 day 1828
at 8 AM spoke the Ship
Eagle again, Long 159-30 Lat 30-00

Sunday June the 14 day 1829
at 7 PM spoke the Ship
Pion of Warrington Capt Coffin
6 Months out with 70 blks and
a Boiling, Long 159-30, Lat 30-00
