With 400 blbls of oil lat  $29^{\circ} 30'$  long  $169^{\circ} 00'$

Thursday May 13<sup>th</sup> Saw Spoke the  
Richard Michel Baker of Nantucket  
9 Months out With 400 blbls of oil in  
Company With the Bear Coffin of  
Nantucket 280 blbls of oil  
lat  $29^{\circ} 40'$  long  $169^{\circ} 00'$  East

Sunday May 16<sup>th</sup> Saw a Ship to  
Leeward did not speak here  
lat  $30^{\circ} 00'$  long  $169^{\circ} 30'$  E

Sunday May 23<sup>rd</sup> Spoke the Orion Freeman  
of Nantucket 4 Months out With 160 blbls of oil  
lat  $30^{\circ} 27'$  long  $170^{\circ} 50'$  East
