

A list of Whales got in the Ship Richmond
Capt by Philip Smith on a voyage around
Cape Horn & sailed from New Bedford the
6th of September 1828 and got the
first Whale with the harbour boat
the list is as follows

Tuesday December the 23 the harbour boat got
one Seal Whale in the lat 46° South long 82° 10' West

Monday January the 19th 1829 the harbour boat got
one Seal Whale and the harbour boat got
a rather Seal Whale in lat 16° 30' long 81°

Wednesday January the 27 the Waste boat got
two Seal Whales lat 51° 00' South long 110° 00' West

Thursday January the 28 the Starboard boat
got one Seal Whale lat 8° 00' S long 110° 00' W

Wednesday February the 18 the Starboard boat
got one School Whale lat 30° 5' South

Saturday February the 21 the Waste boat
got one large Whale lat 51° 01' S long

Wednesday April 2 the Starboard boat got one
Seal Whale lat 20° 45' S long 115° W

A list of the Ships Whales got in the year 1829
Wednesday April the 15 the Starboard boat got a
Seal Whales

And the harbour boat got a Seal Whales

And the Waste boat got 1 Seal Whale
lat 51° 00' North long 115° West

Friday June 12 the Waste boat got one Seal
Whale in the lat 30° 8' long 169° 08' West

Monday June 15 the Waste boat got one
Large Whale lat 30° 30' S long 170° W

Sunday June 21 the Starboard boat
got one Seal Whale lat 30° 8' long 169° W

Friday July 12 the Starboard boat got one large
Whale in

And the Waste boat got one large Whale

And the harbour boat got one large Whale
in the lat 35° 00' S long 177° 00' West

Saturday July 25 the harbour boat got one Seal
Whale in the lat 32° 33' S long 176° W
