 when middle & latter part strange
 winds from N. E. thick & rainy steering
 by N. by W. until 10 AM tack to the
 S. E. under short sail no alt Lat 41° 28' N.

Saturday Dec 7th
 Comes with a strong N. E. wind
 with rain steering by E. S. E. at 4
 AM wind veered to S. W. steering N. E.
 with a heavy swell with showers
 of fog Lat 41° 25' N. Long 71° 31' W.

Sunday Dec 8th
 Comes with strong winds from the
 S. W. steering E. N. E. until 7 AM
 steering N. E. wind W. S. W. & pleasant
 Lat 41° 27' N. Long 71° 14' W.
 Long by Lunar 71° 5'

Thursday Dec 13th
 Comes with light and variable winds steering
 N. E. Lat 41° 22' N. Long 71° 12' W.

Friday Dec 14th
 Comes with light & variable winds from
 E. to N. E. heading to the N. W. and
 N. W. by E. Lat 41° 21' N. Long 71° 25' W.
