Thursday 10mo 29 These 24 hours commence with fresh
breezes from the South and a Squally with rain middle and
latter part the same two sails in sight steering by the
wind up to N S W Lat 6.18 Long 20.44

Friday 10mo 30 Commences with breezes from the South
and a cloudy all hands engaged at fitting rigging two
sails in sight steering by the wind up to N S W

Saturday 10 31. All these 24 hours fresh breezes from
S E and a cloudy getting rigging &c Course S

Sunday 11mo 1 Commences with fresh breezes from
S E and a pleasant middle and latter part Squally
saw a shoal of Black fish Lat 12 Long 21.27

Monday 11mo 2 These 24 hours commence with fresh
breezes from S E and a pleasant middle and
latter part Squally steering by the wind up to
South East Lat 10.03 Long 21.57

Tuesday 11mo 3 All these 24 hours fresh breezes
from S E and a Squally At 1/2 past 2 A.M. Beng
Baker the Cook parted with this life after having
been unwell for about 3 weeks steering by the wind
up to S S W Lat 10.03 Long 22.45

Wednesday 11mo 4 All these 24 hours pleasant weather and
fresh breezes from S S W all hands engaged at sundry
jobs steering by the wind up to S S W

Thursday 11mo 5 These 24 hours fresh breezes
and pleasant weather crossed the line last
night but saw nothing of Neptune suppose he
must have been asleep or engaged in shaving
some ships company to windward steering by the
wind up to S S W all hands engaged in taring
&c Lat 10.03 Long 24.11

Friday 11mo 6 All these 24 hours strong Gales from
the windward & clear all hands engaged
taring &c

Saturday 11mo 7 These 24 hours commence with strong
Gales from the windward and a pleasant middle
and latter more moderate Course South by West
steering full & by Lat 8.35 Long 25.27

Sunday 11mo 8 These 24 hours commence with
fresh Gales from N E and a pleasant weather middle
and latter part clear At 2 A.M. set fore topmast
steering Sails Course S S W by W Lat 8.14 Long 26.24

Monday 11mo 9 These 24 hours moderate Gales from
E S E At 3 A.M. set Topmast & Lower steering sails
all hands employed at taring the rigging &c
steering S S W by S Lat 8.03 Long 27.35

Tuesday 11mo 10 All these 24 hours moderate Gales
from E S E and a pleasant All hands engaged at sundry
jobs saw several Rippers Course S S W by South

Wednesday 11mo 11 All these 24 hours light Gales from
E S E and a clear weather Course S S W by W Lat 12.51 Long 28.46

Thursday 11mo 12 All these 24 hours light Gales from
E S E and a cloudy saw two sails and several junks
Course S S W by S Lat 14.35 Long 29.58

Friday 11mo 13 These 24 hours commence with
moderate Gales from E S E and a cloudy middle
part the same latter Squally and wind from S E
thus ends all well Course S W

Saturday 11mo 14 These 24 hours commence with
fresh Gales and a weather clear At 9 A.M. saw
a sail steering South called her a man of war
the watches engaged at sundry jobs thus ends all
well steering S W two middle & latter part the same

Sunday 11mo 15 All these 24 fresh Gales from the
N E and a clear weather Course S W by S

Monday 11mo 16 These 24 hours commence with fresh
breezes from the E S E and a weather clear At 5
A.M. saw a sail steering E S E middle and
latter part the same Course S W by S

Tuesday 11mo 17 These 24 hours commence with
moderate Gales and a cloudy middle Squally with
rain latter part calm Course S W by W At 8
P.M. set foretopmast & Main Top Gallant mudding
sails saw a sword fish thus ends all well
