and clear weather

Monday 8 Mo 15 These 24 hours commenced with
strong Gale and clear made part the same
later part strong winds At 6 P M saw whales
off our weather beam Dist 3 miles tackled and
hauled away without success whales running fast
to the windward Lat 4.11 Long 109.15

Tuesday 8 Mo 16 These 24 hours commenced with
strong Gale clear weather later part saw whale
running away whales running fast
to the windward on beam at 11 P M lowered
and got a 30 000 whale to the west Boat
Wednesday Lat 4.11 Long 109.30

8 Mo 17 These 24 hours commenced
with Breeze E S E at anchor cutting in the
Whale made part failed the cat and got it
overboard squally with rain later part boating

Thursday 8 Mo 18 Lat 4.2 Long 109.16
These 24 hours fresh Gale from S E and clear
Boating and C. Lat Long West

Friday 8 Mo 19 These 24 hours fresh Gale from S E
with light boating and a small sail ship
to the windward chasing whales but got none

Sat 8 Mo 20 These 24 hours strong Gale from
E S E and clear saw whales a bunching to the
windward Dist 10 miles Lat 4.19 S Long 109.00

Sat 8 Mo 21 These 24 hours light Gale from the E
made and later part the same signal this day
Lat 4.19 Long 109.50

Sunday 8 Mo 22 These 24 hours light Gale and
clear at 6 P M saw a throat of whales
to hit to catch on Mr Songled

Monday 8 Mo 22. 1836 Stowed down our oil
and mended the mainsail the weather moderate
wind from the E S E. Lat 4.14 S Long 109.13

Tuesday 8 Mo 23 Saw a throat of whales toward
and got one to the S E moderate weather wind from
the Eastward Lat 4.40 S Long 109.30

Wednesday 24 Boiling out our whale At 4 A M saw
a whale bunching to the windward light winds clear
weather thus ends all well Lat 4.50 S Long 109.30

Thursday 25 Begins with squalls from the E
repairing the mainsail Lat 4.57 S Long 109.10

Friday 26 Commenced with light Gale with
squalls nothing more remarkable Lat 4.26 S Long 109.20

Saturday 27 of 8 Mo Set up the main top Mast
stayed back stays and main stay later part stowed
down our oil at 6 A M saw a throat of whales

3 ships in chase whales to the windward
round 3 boats and pulled to the windward without
success our ship took a whale along side much to my
disappointment made enough of oil

Sunday 28 Two sail in sight on to the windward
the other to off our the beam At 5 P M spoke the Bar
Tahiti of Salina 9 mo out 350 tbs of oil
Lat 4.30 Long 110.

Monday 29 Begins with light Gale
from the E and pleasant a number of sail
in sight Lat 4.47 Long 110.

Tuesday 30 These 24 hours pleasant weather
moderate Gale thus ends all well Lat 4.19 Long 110.6

Wednesday 31 Commenced with light wind
from the E S E and clear later part shift of
wind to the West
