

Friday 9th Mo 23 1836

Triang. Commenced with strong Gale from the ESE and clear morning SE by E later part cloudy south east rain and said Eastern Island bearing SE by S Dist 217 miles. Lat 24.7 Long 111.50

Saturday 24 Commenced with clear weather middle and later part the same

Sunday 25 At 1/2 past 3 PM made Eastern Star bearing SE by E Dist 30 miles and down for it At 1/2 past 3 AM. took in standing sails at any light the land close by at 7 AM. hove to and the water and last round boat and on shore and got Potatoes Yams and Saffron

Monday 26 Standing off and on the boats came on board and went on shore again after Yams At 11 PM came back and made sail stood SE by E middle and later part clearing more top work on my ship

Tuesday 27 Commenced with strong winds from NW and overcast wind from opposite points of the compass the middle part stormy ESE later part calking the Bows

Wednesday 28 These 24 hours light winds from the N by E and Clear middle and later part the same

Thursday 29 These 24 hours light Gale from the NE and pleasant middle part the same later part wind from the NW stormy E by N Lat 29.45 Long 108.29

Saturday 9th Mo 30 1836

Finished calking ships Bows At 4 PM set the lower standing sails middle part commenced standing Boats Crew watched later part coal Taring & ~~was~~ took in the lower standing sails and hauled to the NE and East Sat 9th Mo 31 Lat 29.46 Long 98.30 West

The first part of this 24 hours light winds from the SE by N middle and later part the same

Sunday 32 First part of this 24 hours light winds from the NW and clear middle part light puffs with calms from the SE stormy ESE later part with from the NW stormy E by S Lat 29.47 S Long 98

Monday 3 Wind hauled to the SE and took in the lower standing sails

Stormy full wind by up to NE by E middle part the same later part heavy with rain

Tuesday 4 These 24 hours light Gale from the NE by N and Clear middle and later part the same Lat 28.45 Long 49.513

Wednesday 5 The first part of this 24 hours light winds from the N by E and Clear middle and later part the same Lat 28.57 Long 49.45

Thursday 6 These 24 hours light Gale and pleasant later part went to the top of the Bows and repaired it

Friday 7 These 24 hours commenced with strong winds and pleasant from the NW middle part very light wind from the N by E and overcast later part hoisted up Lat Long 49.45
