

Saturday 10 Mo 8 1836

These 24 hours light Gale from the N by E and pleasant middle and latter calm at 8 Am. wind hauled to the N.W.

Sunday 9 First part of these 24 hours light wind from the N.W. set the Topmast and Top Gale standing sails at 3 P.M. took in the Top Gale standing sail middle part wind from the N.W. and very light latter part took in Topmast standing sails

Lat 29 or Long 86.86

Monday 10 First part light wind from the N.W. & clear middle part set the Topmast standing sail latter part set the Top Gale standing sail This ends all well

Lat 27.09 Long 85.28

Tuesday 11 First part light wind from N by W and clear middle part the same latter part rainy so ends all well

Wednesday 12 At 1 P.M. saw whales lowered away and fastened the waist Boat - whales very shy middle part light wind. latter part called in heads and cut them in

Thursday 13 First part these 24 hours light breeze with rain squalls boiling &c

Friday 14 These 24 hours finished fogging & hooped. latter part clear hoisted out the starboard pump and hooped it

Saturday 15 first light wind from the N.W. and clear middle and latter part light winds from the S.E. during N by W

Sunday 16 These 24 hours commence with calm middle part calm with { at 2 P.M. lowered away the waist Boat - light Buffs from the South after Pump Backs At 4 P.M. came by W latter part the same road took set Topmast and Lower Mast sails at 5 P.M. took in the lower standing
